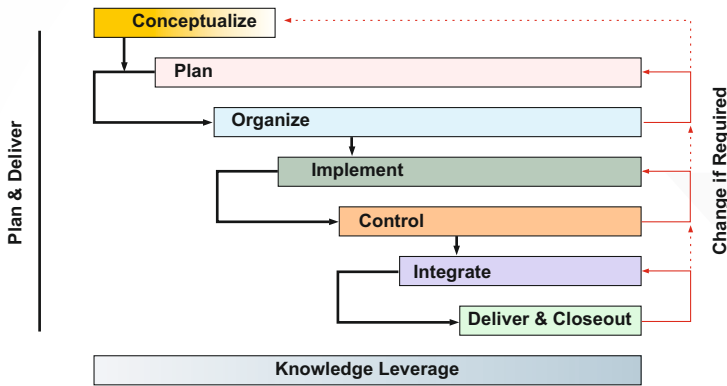

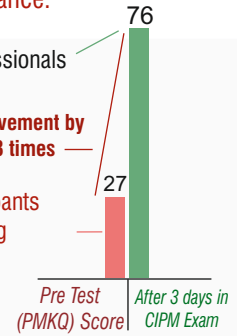

- The curriculum of project management was finalised by the Task Force members considering all the syllabus of the global certification bodies including i2P2M.



The syllabus of CIPM exam is in aligned with the NITI Aayog's recommended project management curriculum. **There is no other PM institution including PMI, which is in compliance with the salient recommendations of NITI Aayog as can be seen from the excerpts mentioned above.**
- The Certificate In Project Management (CIPM) administered by i2P2M is the only ISO/IEC17024:2012 accredited PM credential from Quality Council of India. i2P2M being a certification body demonstrates adherence to internationally recognised practices and builds trust amongst stakeholders.
- CIPM exam is the most robust exam amongst other PM certification bodies. Exam has negative marking for wrong answers unlike any other PM certification bodies. Further, exam paper has 4 sections and candidates need to pass each section independently as well as the entire paper. **i2P2M is the only one globally having such a rigour.**
